This letter is the Department of Education's fourth interim response to the above-referenced requests for information pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. § 552.

In accordance with the parties' Joint Status Report, filed on April 8, 2024, the Department has made decisions to release 783 pages responsive to these FOIA requests and a link to the records is included in the email accompanying this response. Certain information, however, has been withheld according to the FOIA exemption(s) specified below:

- 1. Records or portions of records relating to certain intra-agency information is exempt from disclosure pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552 (b)(5) of the FOIA. This exemption permits the withholding of inter- or intra-agency information that could be withheld under civil discovery (including information protected by the deliberative process privilege, attorney-client communication privilege, and attorney work product privilege); and
- 2. Records or portions of records relating to personal information are exempt pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6) of the FOIA. Disclosure of this information would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.
