Executive Summary

On May 29, 2026, the White House’s Office of Management and Budget (OMB) proposed a [Regulation for Federal Financial Assistance](#) that seeks, among other things, to ensure that federal agencies do not use unlawful diversity, equity, and inclusion (DEI) ideology as a basis for awarding taxpayer funding to projects. While that proposed rule represents a necessary step toward the Trump Administration’s laudable goal of restoring lawful, neutral, and merit-based criteria to federal grantmaking, this report identifies a practical gap that agencies and recipients could otherwise exploit in spite of this and other positive efforts: the risk that recipients of federal funding will use intersectionality and related identity-politics frameworks to preserve identity-based preferences under newer, more technical terminology.

The spending record makes the policy concern concrete. This report identifies [nearly 250 federal award records on USAspending.gov using the keyword “intersectionality.”](#) with approximately \$230 million in reported obligations and \$140 million in reported outlays, subject to ordinary USAspending.gov updates and reconciliation. The awards show that intersectionality has moved from academic theory into taxpayer-funded programs, including research, training, outreach, equity measurement, technical assistance, institutional-change projects, and program design.

The response should be targeted and practical. OMB should clarify that neither agencies nor recipients of federal funding may use protected characteristics directly, through proxies, or through intersectional composite categories when the practical effect is preferential or adverse treatment.

In addition to such clarification by OMB, President Trump should issue an executive order, building on existing executive orders and policies addressing DEI, unlawful discrimination, and merit-based federal action, to close the intersectionality loophole expressly. Agencies should then issue conforming guidance documents so grant officers, contracting officers, program staff, reviewers, auditors, and recipients understand that intersectionality and equivalent identity-stacking frameworks cannot be used to evade neutral, merit-based rules.

The Identity–Politics Loophole

In April 2026, the Legal Insurrection Foundation (LIF) and the Defense of Freedom Institute for Policy Studies (DFI) published a [report](#) explaining the rise of intersectionality as a discriminatory ideology that seeks to delegitimize existing institutions and describing how it has become a central mechanism within the broader identity-politics ecosystem. It can appear under different labels, including racial equity, gender equity, climate justice, multiculturalism, LGBTQ+ inclusion, lived experience, and similar formulations. That flexibility is precisely why OMB should address it directly by ensuring that federal agencies and recipients of taxpayer funding cannot evade neutral rules through new vocabulary or composite identity categories.

Once the intersectionality framework enters a grant program, it can shape who qualifies, who receives priority, how applications are scored, what recipients must report, and what compliance burdens they must satisfy based on the number of distinct or overlapping “marginalized” categories beneficiaries

might claim to justify project funding. In practice, it turns equal treatment into identity accounting.

The Spending Record

This concern about the use of an intersectionality framework in federal grantmaking is not theoretical. As of this report's publication, a search of the federal public data portal USAspending.gov [identifies](#) 249 records of federal assistance awards using the keyword “intersectionality.” The data reflects approximately \$230 million in obligations (committed spending) and approximately \$140 million in outlays (amounts already paid). The largest spending was concentrated between 2022 and 2024, averaging roughly \$75 million to \$80 million per year. Most importantly for immediate executive action, roughly 100 of the identified awards appear to remain active based on their periods of performance, meaning this is not merely a retrospective accounting problem but an ongoing pipeline of federal spending that agencies can still review, redirect, suspend, or allow to expire under lawful criteria.

The award-level data gives those totals practical significance. The examples span the National Institutes of Health, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration, Food and Drug Administration, and Administration for Community Living at the Department of Health and Human Services, as well as the Department of Justice, Agency for International Development, Department of Commerce, Department of Defense, Department of State, National Science Foundation (NSF), Institute of Museum and Library Services, and other federal components. They also reveal a continuing pipeline: many performance periods extend into 2027, 2028, 2029, and 2030—well into the next presidential administration—meaning already-obligated funds may continue converting into expended taxpayer money unless agencies redirect them through lawful criteria.

The largest examples are not merely niche academic studies or conference grants. The appendix includes \$14.25 million to Drexel University for “Catalyzing Systemic Change at Drexel University to Support Diverse Faculty in Health Disparities,” \$10.99 million to the New Hampshire Department of Health for cancer prevention and control programs, \$8.16 million to New York University for a “National Center for Engagement in Diabetes Equity Research,” \$7.53 million to the University of California, San Francisco, for an Asian

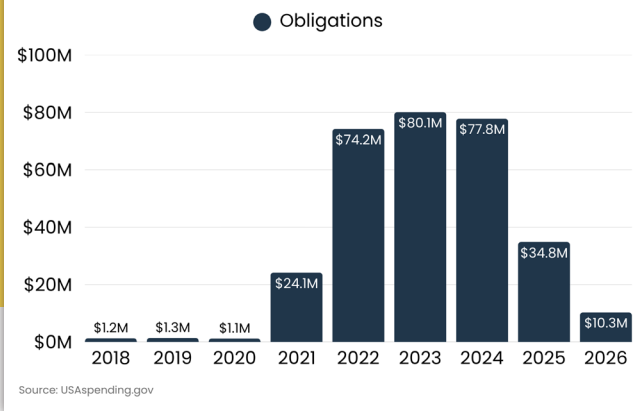
American cancer cohort, \$4.38 million to Rutgers for a Disability Employer Practices research center, \$4.34 million to the Illinois Department of Public Health for rape prevention and education, and \$4 million to Vanderbilt University for an autism self-advocacy center for equity and neurodiversity in engineering.

The concern is not the underlying subject matter—cancer research, health research, disability services, violence prevention, or STEM education may all serve legitimate missions that comply with applicable statutory language. The concern is whether grants for those purposes are awarded, scored, conditioned, reported, or administered through identity-politics frameworks, intersectional categories, or ideological assumptions about group status in a manner that violates civil rights laws and ignores the actual aims of the statutes that authorize them.

Other awards explicitly use intersectionality, intersectional stigma, intersectional discrimination, intersectional minority stress, or comparable identity-stacking language in the project title or description. Examples include \$1.03 million to the University of California, San Francisco, for “Women, Intersectionality, Substance Use and HIV”; \$848,365 to the Research Foundation for SUNY for “Intersectional Minority Stress, Mental Health, and HIV Treatment”; \$799,904 to the University of North Texas for “Inclusion, Identity and Intersectionality”; \$650,893 to Georgia State University for “An Intersectional Approach Linking Minority Stressors”; \$584,580 to Whitman-Walker Institute for “Intersectional Discrimination and Linkage to HIV Prevention and Care”; \$510,597 to the University of New Mexico for “Intersectionality as Inquiry and Praxis”; and \$138,000 to a redacted recipient for “Intersectionality and Implicit Bias.”

The USAspending.gov records include examples in which the NSF has embedded the framework in STEM, engineering, computing, faculty retention, mentoring, inclusion, and institutional-change programs. The appendix includes \$2.47 million to Montgomery College, Maryland, for upward socioeconomic mobility, \$3.5 million to Molloy University for a Louis Stokes STEM pathways alliance, nearly \$3 million to Iowa State University for a Louis Stokes STEM pathways and research alliance, \$2.98 million to Education Development Center for an AGEP national research conference series, \$2.40 million to Arizona State University for “Black Girls as Creators,” \$1 million to Georgia State University for “Intersectionality and Mentoring in the Professoriate,” and \$982,345 to the University of New Mexico for “Intersectionality in Building STEM Entrepreneurship Capacity.” These examples are consistent with a 2018 [Washington Free Beacon report](#) identifying 101 NSF-funded intersectionality projects totaling more than \$62.5 million from 2014 to 2018. It appears that this publicity involving its funding targets has done nothing to deter NSF from injecting intersectional ideology into STEM disciplines.

The outlay pattern shows why the issue is urgent. Some large awards, including Drexel University’s \$14.25 million award with \$9.35 million outlaid and New Hampshire’s \$10.99 million award with \$7.92 million outlaid, are mostly spent, but others remain heavily obligated but lightly outlaid. For instance, only \$161,285 of Vanderbilt University’s \$4 million award is outlaid, and the appendix records \$0 outlaid for North Carolina State University’s \$816,031 award for “Leveraging Intersectionality and Engineering Affinity Groups.” In other words, the records indicate that there is a significant amount of future spending that can be prevented.

The figures above provide strong evidence that intersectionality has migrated from seminar rooms into federal grant awards. It is no longer merely an academic theory or a stray phrase in a few grant abstracts; it is a wide-ranging framework that federal agencies have put into practice to obligate or spend taxpayer money.

Why Intersectionality Is Dangerous in Grantmaking

Intersectionality creates risk in grantmaking because it can allow unlawful identity-based decision-making to continue while appearing more technical and less explicit. A funding notice may avoid overt racial or sex classifications while still preferring composite identity groups. That result is not genuine neutrality; it is preferential treatment by multiplication of categories.

The problem is not that government may never measure real need. It can use lawful, objective indicators such as income, unemployment, geography, disease burden, disaster impact, service gaps, or other statutory criteria. The problem arises when government ranks people according to ideological assumptions about oppression and privilege based on group membership.

Waste and Burden

Intersectionality also produces waste beyond the awards themselves. Recipients can be pulled into trainings, subjective reporting systems, internal equity reviews, workshops, equity measurement, technical assistance, and compliance exercises

built around vague ideological concepts rather than measurable program outcomes.

Staff time and grant dollars move away from actual program delivery and toward process rituals. Outside assistance may be funded. Reports are produced. Boxes are checked. Meanwhile, the public purpose of the grant recedes into the background.

The award-level data reinforces this point. Examples include the National Center for Disability, Equity, and Intersectionality; an “intersectional” HIV stigma measure in South Africa; a curriculum in reproductive health care equity; a symposium on artificial intelligence in veterinary medicine described through intersectionality language; and museum programming updated by applying an intersectional lens. These are the kinds of activities that convert grant dollars into ideology-administration rather than measurable statutory service delivery. This is a wasteful use of federal funding that prioritizes the minutiae of academic bureaucracy over addressing the real-world issues identified in federal spending laws.

Proposed Executive Action

OMB’s [Regulation for Federal Financial Assistance](#), proposed on May 29, 2026, and prohibiting unlawful preferences based on protected characteristics in federal grants and agreements, represents a critical step in the right direction. But if the final rule prohibits unlawful DEI preferences, proxies for protected characteristics, and disparate-impact methodologies without naming intersectionality, agencies and recipients may preserve the same practices through composite terminology.

On July 9, 2026, LIF and DFI submitted to OMB a public comment letter proposing a targeted solution to bolster the final rule: make clear that protected characteristics cannot be used directly, through proxies, or through composite “intersectional” categories when those methods produce preferential or adverse treatment. That clarification should govern program planning, funding notices, merit review, risk review, award conditions, national policy requirements, cost allowability, monitoring, audits, and closeout. Although OMB’s proposed reforms are aimed in the right direction, naming intersectionality would help ensure those reforms reach one of the chief frameworks used to preserve identity-based preferences under more technical language.

In addition to OMB’s clarification that the framework of intersectionality is not a valid basis for federal grants and agreements, the president should issue an executive order that sweeps more broadly to ensure that taxpayer funds are not used to advance intersectionality, DEI preferences, or any equivalent system that sorts, scores, favors, burdens, or targets individuals or communities according to protected characteristics, proxy categories, or composite identity labels. The order should direct every agency to review active and pending awards for intersectional terms and practices, including “intersecting forms of marginalization,” “women of color,” “BIPOC,” “LGBTQIA+,” “immigrants,” “equity-centered,” “anti-racist,” and similar formulations when they operate as identity-based preferences or compliance conditions.

The order should also require agencies to report identified awards to OMB, prevent new solicitations that rely on intersectional criteria, remove unlawful scoring preferences from funding notices, bar the use of federal funds for ideological trainings or consultant-driven equity exercises, and recover or redirect funds where award conditions or costs violate law or policy. Agencies should remain free to address real need, as identified in the statutory language authorizing grant programs, through objective measures such as income, geography, disability accommodations required by law, unemployment, disease burden, disaster impact, service gaps, or other statutory criteria. They should not use those measures as pretexts for identity politics.

The executive order should be paired with agency guidance documents. Those documents should translate the government-wide directive into operational rules for notices of funding opportunity, merit-review criteria, cost allowability, award conditions, recipient certifications, audits, corrective-action plans, training materials, technical-assistance contracts, and closeout. Guidance should also provide examples of prohibited language and practices, including the use of intersectionality as a scoring preference, eligibility condition, reporting category, training requirement, consultant deliverable, or proxy for protected-characteristic decision-making.

This approach is necessary because existing directives targeting DEI may not capture newer labels that perform the same discriminatory function. Intersectionality can appear as a technical research method, an equity framework, a community-needs assessment, a lived-experience requirement, or a composite category. The OMB clarification, an additional executive order, and implementing agency guidance would remove ambiguity by making clear that the prohibition turns on function, not labels.

Conclusion

Identity politics is adaptive. If one label becomes legally vulnerable, another can replace it. Intersectionality is especially dangerous because it allows identity-based decision-making to continue under newer, more-technical language while claiming to serve equity, inclusion, or community need.

The Trump Administration deserves strong support for confronting unlawful discrimination and restoring merit-based federal grantmaking. But the needed response should not stop with existing executive orders or OMB’s final rule stripping DEI from federal financial assistance. The Administration should issue an additional executive order, as a supplement to existing orders and

policies addressing DEI and unlawful identity-based decision-making, to close the intersectionality loophole across grants, cooperative agreements, other federal assistance awards, guidance, trainings, compliance requirements, and agency reporting systems. That order should direct agencies to identify, suspend, terminate, or allow to expire awards and requirements that use intersectionality or equivalent identity-stacking frameworks to sort, score, favor, burden, or target people based on protected characteristics, proxy categories, or ideological assumptions about group status.

OMB’s clarification of its final regulations, as proposed by LIF and DFI, would be an important part of that effort, but it should operate within a broader executive policy and a coordinated agency-guidance process.

Federal funds should advance statutory purposes, neutral criteria, and measurable public needs, not identity-politics systems repackaged as intersectionality. Naming intersectionality directly in an executive order, in OMB’s final rule, and in agency guidance would close a practical gap, reinforce lawful equal treatment, and make clear that neither government nor recipients of federal financial assistance can evade civil rights law by stacking protected characteristics into a new label.

Appendix Summary

The appendix accompanying this report compiles award-level examples from a USAspending.gov search for federal assistance awards using the keyword “intersectionality.” It shows a broad, multi-agency spending pattern rather than a small set of isolated awards. The identified awards span health research, STEM education, disability policy, violence-prevention programs, technical assistance, institutional-transformation projects, conferences, curricula, equity measurement, and program-design activity.

The appendix data supports the central concern set forth in this report: it reveals approximately \$230 million in reported obligations, approximately \$140 million in reported outlays, and a significant number of active awards with performance periods extending into future fiscal years. Some large awards are mostly spent; others remain heavily obligated but lightly outlaid. That

mix gives federal agencies two tasks at once: account for past spending and prevent future spending from being converted into identity-based grant administration.

The appendix does not show that every listed project lacks any lawful public purpose. Rather, it shows a pressing need for federal agencies to distinguish legitimate statutory missions from the goals of identity politics. Federal funds may support lawful health, education, disability, safety, or research goals, but they should not be awarded, scored, conditioned, monitored, or reported through intersectional identity categories or ideological assumptions about group status.
